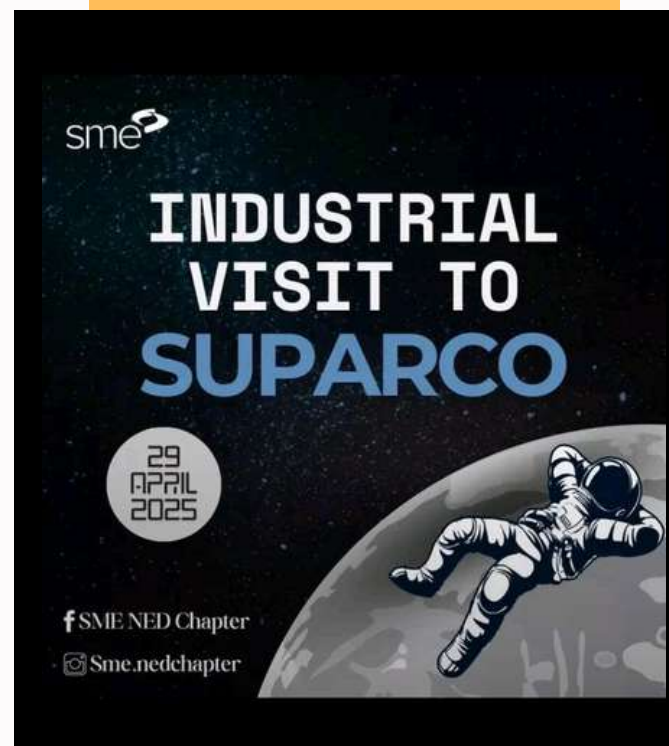
NKR Engineering Pvt. Ltd. - Apr 16, 2025
